The Labor Commissioner, by and through the Division has conducted an investigation and determined that violations of Labor Code section 1771 and 1777.5 have been committed by the contractor and/or subcontractor identified above on the above-named project. We found the sum of \$2,405.92 as due and owing.


The violations are broken down as follows:

Wages Owed:	\$1,256.48
Labor Code 1775 Penalties:	\$740 (37 violations x \$20/violation)
Labor Code 1813 Penalties:	\$100 (4 violations x \$25/violation)
Training Funds Owed:	\$189.44
Labor Code 1777.7 Penalties:	\$120 (6 violations x \$20/violation)
TOTAL:	\$2,405.92

Accordingly, please remit the sum of \$2,405.92 by Wednesday, October 28, 2020 close of business. Please be further advised that if no payment is received, a Civil Wage and Penalty Assessment will be issued for all the amounts listed above with the Labor Code sections 1775 at \$40/violation and 1777.7 at \$40/violation. The cashier's check should be made payable to the **State Labor Commissioner** and mailed to the State of California, Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards Enforcement, Bureau of Field Enforcement Cashiering Unit 100, 2031 Howe Avenue Suite 100, Sacramento, CA 95825-0196 with the above mentioned case number on the cashier's check.
